## Mohit Sharma, FIIRSM

In this interview, Mohit Sharma highlights his career to date, the reasons why he became a risk and safety management professional and how joining IIRSM can help you build and strengthen your skills, and support professional development

### **Tell us about your background, your current role and IIRSM membership grade**

I work as Project Health Safety Environment Manager at Technip Energies in Delhi, India. Assisting project leads on overall management and performance, I provide advice on compliance and the implementation of relevant environment health and safety (EHS) legislative regulations and requirements as well as company EHS policies, standards and initiatives at project sites.

I have been awarded IIRSM Fellowship and am also a chartered member of IOSH and a professional member of ASSP. I am IIRSM India's branch chair.

### **What prompted you to become a risk and safety management professional?**

My interest in risk and safety management developed gradually. I had started as an engineering designer after earning my bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering. I had just completed my first year with an engineering design company when one of our clients visited to discuss

an automobile incident. One of the main causes was the vehicle's design. This led to detailed discussions with the client's safety, research and development and engineering team and spurred my interest in analysis, audit methodologies and further research into health and safety.

I began to think that I could help provide solutions to workplace risks and collaborate with stakeholders to improve the effectiveness of risk management in a more practical role. I left my job and enrolled on a one-year full-time postgraduate diploma in health and safety. Since taking on my first role in the industry, my journey in risk and safety management has continued.

### **Tell us about why you joined IIRSM and how it has helped you**

As a safety and risk management professional, I have always recognised how important continual professional development (CPD) is, so I joined IIRSM in 2019. It has helped me to maintain my CPD and without it I would never have furthered my career as far as I have.

Joining IIRSM has also enabled me to be part of an international community and gain insights into risk management globally.

In addition, IIRSM showcases what's happening at a regional and global level and provides an opportunity to network with likeminded professionals. Through this I have broadened my knowledge.
